As can be seen in the below quote, DMA Absorption/Polishing Filters for safe and extraordinary cleaning of Bilge Water, is, according to our interpretation, acknowledged by USCG to be used as an add on to the existing OWS on board, as long as it is not interfering directly with the performance of the OWS.

The system is Type approved by Lloyd's Register, but does not have a type approval as such from USCG.
